

Revised Hawai'i Environmental Review Process

Under the Emergency Proclamation Relating to Housing

Project Proponent submits the following for review:

- Documentation necessary under Section 5 of the proclamation's administrative rules
- All comments and responses made pursuant to plan for public input
- Any additional documents/information requested by the Lead Housing Officer (LHO) in consideration of this determination



The proposing/approving agency or LHO makes a determination for each certified project whether the project is likely to cause the irreversible and irretrievable commitment of resources that cannot be mitigated should it be implemented, or when the cumulative impact of planned successive actions in the same place, over time, is significant, or when an action that is normally insignificant may be significant.

Significant



The project does not qualify for the suspension of Chapter 343. The project must follow the Hawai'i Environmental Review Process under chapter 343, HRS.

Not Significant



Project qualifies for the suspension of Chapter 343. Project proponents may proceed after electronically publishing the determination on the Office of the Governor website and submitting the determination to the OPD ERP for publication in the environmental notice bulletin.



Any terms under which the determination has been made shall be set forth in the project's development agreement and shall be binding upon the project proponent.
